

WORKING AT COSTA BERRIES



ACCOMMODATION

We do not provide accommodation, however there are many hostels and shared houses within the surrounding area.



TRAVEL

We do not provide travel to/ around the farm. It is advised that you have your own transport or arrange your own reliable transport.



PAY

Most positions are paid per piece rate. We have a small number of hourly paid roles. The Berry Category Enterprise Agreement outlines the arrangements.



THE FARM

Costa Corindi is based on around 350Ha. The farm operates all year round, and the majority of work is performed outside. We provide drinking water, toilets and have a Work Health & Safety Team on site.



ARRANGEMENTS

You will be assigned a role at an induction. The role can vary depending on harvest needs. Raspberries work 5-6 days per week, blueberries 5-7 days per week and maintenance roles 5-6 days per week.



WEATHER

The Mid-North Coast has temperatures ranging from 15°C to 25°C however this can vary. You need to be able to work in all conditions throughout the season.



VISAS

The work performed qualifies towards the working holiday visa. It is your responsibility to keep payslips, piece rate agreement and EA agreement as evidence when applying for the next visa.



WORKING PERIOD

Raspberries are picked all year around however they will experience highs and lows. Blueberries are picked July - Jan each year. Training is provided and performance is monitored all season.
